

# Shoot Attendance 2011

The following shoot attendance figures and Competition Factors were used in selecting the 2012 ATA All-American teams (based on 2011 target-year accomplishments).

Grand American Week events ("Championships" in the table below) have a fixed Competition Factor of 10; Grand American Preliminary Week events ("Preliminary" in the table below) have a fixed Competition Factor of 8.

For all other shoots, the Competition Factor is determined by entry figures in the three championship events, as shown. Satellite Grand Americans and ATA Zone Shoots have a minimum Competition Factor of 3 and a maximum of 7; state/provincial shoots plus "Other Major Tournaments" have a minimum Competition Factor of 2 and a maximum of 7.

All "Other Major Tournaments" which met the qualifications to be All-American Points-earning shoots in the 2010 ATA target year were automatically All-American Qualifying Shoots in 2011 as well; however, each shoot's Competition Factor is determined by its 2011 attendance.

All-American team selections are substantially guided by the following policy: If a qualifying All-American Points tournament is scheduled to start near the end of the current target year and scheduled to end in the succeeding target year (i.e., spanning the target years) and is canceled for whatever reason subsequent to the tournament start, any qualifying points earned will count toward the ensuing target year for All-American team purposes. (Nevertheless, the targets will be recorded and registered in the expiring target year, in keeping with Rule II, B. [Page 8] of the ATA Rulebook.)
